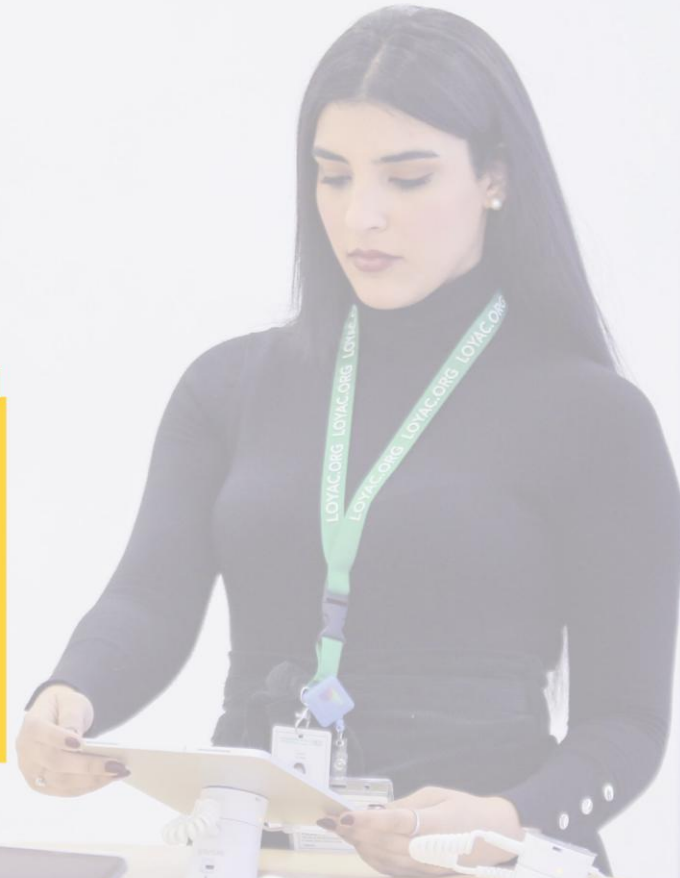

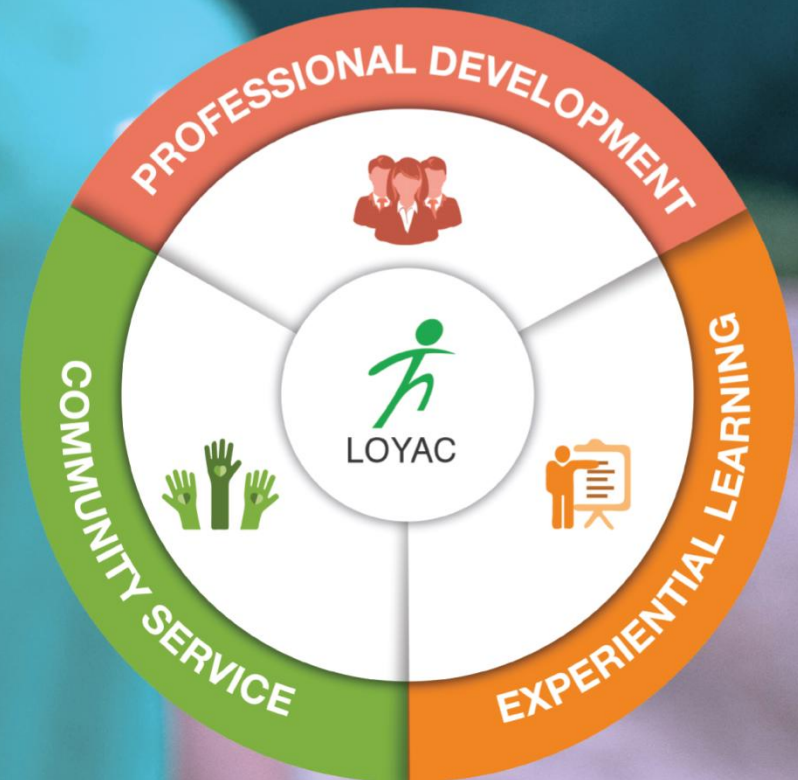

SERVICE IS MY JOY

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Explain the reasons behind the unique behaviors and physiological traits of the following disabilities (Autism, down syndrome, visual impairments, hearing impairments, multiple disabilities, learning disabilities).
- Practice how to properly facilitate special needs individuals' mobility in different situations (ramps, stairs, and narrow paths).
- Empathize with special needs individuals and to behave in a way that is emotionally sensitive and respectful.
- Ability to effectively follow instructions from supervisors.
- Proactively seeking to improve the social well-being of special needs individuals.



AWARENESS COMMITTEES

COMMUNITY SERVICE

This program encourages young people to research and discuss issues on critical challenges that our community is facing. Based on the committee's research results a campaign will be designed to highlight the results and present a solution. The campaign will be covering social media, booths at malls and press releases in the newspapers.

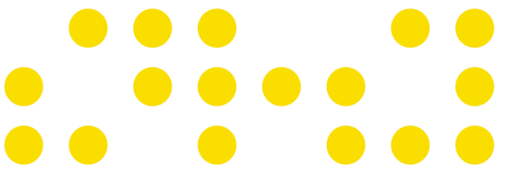
